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Interior Ceilings: Recommended Materials



General Notes:

- 1. Conduct a Life Cycle Cost Analysis: consider the cost of long-term maintenance and eventual replacement
- 2. Exposed steel roof decks and floor decks are preferred in Groups 1, 2 and 3 including high-visibility areas when when systems are ordered, uncluttered, easy to keep clean and fully coodinated with fire sprinkler and other ceiling-mounted infrastructure and components
- 3. Exposed concrete may be used in Groups 1, 2 and 3 including high-visibility areas when systems are ordered, uncluttered, easy to keep clean and fully coodinated with fire sprinkler and other ceiling-mounted infrastructure and components
- 4. Limit gypsum board ceilings in Groups 1 and 2 to accents and wet rooms
- 5. Consider Federal HPSB Guiding Principles green product procurement requirements
