Interior Floors: Recommended Materials



General Notes:

- 1. Conduct a Life Cycle Cost Analysis: consider the cost of long-term maintenance and eventual replacement
- 2. Stained or ground-and-polished concrete slabs are permitted in Group 1 and 2 and high-visibility locations
- 3. Terrazzo is only permitted in high-traffic areas subject to extreme wearing
- 4. Tile is preferred in high-traffic and wet locations only
- 5. Rubber flooring (sheet goods and tile) is preferred for stairs and special applications such as fitness areas; bamboo and cork may be used in low-traffic areas; wood (considered "rapidly-renewable" by some industries) may be used in family housing
- 6. Consider Federal HPSB Guiding Principles green product procurement requirements
